# Father Gilpin Council #9760 Knights of Columbus Scholarship (Revised Sept., 2023)

This scholarship was created in 1998 to mark the 10th anniversary of our Council's founding. It is awarded annually to a Catholic student going into their first year of post-secondary education.

## **Eligibility Regirments:**

- 1. The applicant must be a Knight or child or grandchild of a Knight (or deceased Knight) of a Saskatchewan Council of the Knights of Columbus (District 4).
- 2. The applicant must be accepted to a post-secondary educational institution for their first year of education, within two years of Gr.12 graduation.
- 3. Application must be received no later than May 15.

#### **Selection Committee Criteria:**

- 1. The selection committee will consist of at least three Knights from Fr. Gilpin Council #9760, who are not related to the applicants.
- 2. Preference will first be given to Knights, children and grandchildren of Knights from Fr. Gilpin Council #9760, and then to applicants related to District 4 Knights.

## Fill-in the application and attach:

- 1. A transcript of your marks, including Gr. 12 marks, up to May 15, from your high school.
- 2. A letter of reference from your Principal, Vice-Principal, teacher, or parish priest. Have them include a description of your extra-curricular, community, and church activities.
- 3. A copy of the acceptance letter from the post-secondary institution you will be attending.
